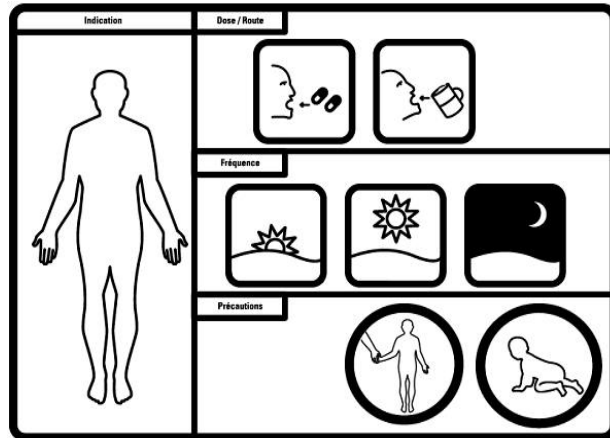


The Pictogram storyboard should be printed on letter size or A4 paper in either portrait or landscape orientation, depending on how the culture reads. It is comprised of 4 areas with a maximum of 4 pictograms in each row.

The format should be standardised to:

Panel 1 – indication
 Row 2 – quantity/dosage form/route
 Row 3 – frequency
 Row 4 – additional information
